## CANADIAN ALL WELSH RULES AND REGULATIONS

---

1. The Canadian All Welsh Championship Committee, the Executive of The Welsh Pony & Cob Association of Ontario, and the owner & management of the Orono Fairgrounds will not be responsible for any claim resulting from injury or injuries to any person, horse or pony, or loss or damage to property, incurred on the Show Grounds.
2. The Committee reserves the right to decline any entry and to return any entry fee before or during the show, without being liable for compensation.
3. **In the case of horses or ponies being entered and not exhibited, entry fees will be forfeited. Refunds on entries will be made only on receipt of a Veterinarian Certificate attesting to the inability of the animal to participate due to illness or injury. The certificate must be in the hands of the Show Secretary prior to the beginning of the Show on Sunday August 1, 2010.**
4. Substitution of animals will not be permitted, with the exception of the criteria in rule #3 being met.
5. The Canadian All Welsh Championships is held under the auspices of The **WELSH PONY AND COB ASSOCIATION OF ONTARIO** and is a **HIGH POINT SHOW** for the Association's High Point Awards.
6. **Advance entries must be received by July 17, 2010.**
7. Competitors must have proof of a minimum of \$1,000,000.00 LIABILITY INSURANCE.
8. Entry fees: will be as noted in this Prize List.

9. For the benefit of the announcer, when filling in your entry form, please use a separate line for each handler/rider/driver if for the same animal.
10. Registration Papers or photocopies of registration papers MUST be available for each animal entered in this Show on the day that you show.
11. Ponies entered in the Breeding and High-Point eligible Performance Classes of this Show must be registered Welsh Mountain, Section A; Welsh Ponies, Section B; Welsh ponies of

Cob Type, Section C; Welsh Cobs, Section D; or registered Half Welsh (with one registered Welsh parent) or foals eligible for registration.

12. **Open Division [OD]** classes are open to all horses and ponies of all breeds, excluding Purebred Welsh or Half-Welsh, except where specifically indicated otherwise.
13. Entries are restricted to members Welsh Pony & Cob Association of Ontario. To apply for membership, please complete the attached membership form and forward to the show secretary along with the appropriate fees prior to the advance-entry close date.
14. **Stallions are not permitted in Junior classes.**
15. **Any dog on the premises must be on a leash.**
16. Winner of cups, trophies and other prizes which are held for annual or repeated competition will be required to execute an agreement to properly care for said prizes and return them to the Show Committee when so requested for the following year's show.
17. **WINNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ENGRAVING.**
18. All drivers 14 years of age or under **MUST** be accompanied by an adult capable of giving assistance if required.
19. Any unruly animal will be excused from its class.
20. The Show reserves the right to combine, cancel, or divide a class.
21. Schooling will be allowed only in designated areas.
22. All questions not covered by these rules shall be decided and interpreted by the Show Chairperson, along with Committee Members, whose decision shall be final.
23. **It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to be fully cognizant of the rules and class specifications governing their divisions.**
24. **It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to know which of their ponies are eligible for Championships and to have them ready and in the show ring on time.**
25. **Please notify the Show Secretary of scratches and tack holds at least two classes in advance. Classes will be held no longer than 5 minutes.**
26. **No exhibitor and/or pony may enter the ring once the judging has commenced.**

## **WELSH CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS**

All Champions will be competing at the Royal Agricultural Winter Fair for THE WELSH CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS. Please Note: Once an animal has qualified for the finals of “THE WELSH CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS, it is no longer eligible to compete for a berth in the final qualifying class. Each Champion going forward to the Finals at the Royal Agricultural Winter Fair will be expected to sign a letter stating that they will be present at the Royal agriculture Winter Fair for the final judging of the WELSH CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS.

Each Division Champion will receive a special Championship Ribbon.

THE WELSH CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS winner will be presented with the PERPETUAL CHALLENGE TROPHY from Blackwood Acres ( to remain with the Royal Agricultural Winter Fair), and engraved CHAMPION OF CHAMPION PLAQUE, a special CHAMPION OF CHAMPION RIBBON and a COOLER. The remaining Qualifiers will each receive an ENGRAVED PLAQUE.

The OWNER and the BREEDER of the WELSH CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS will also receive a commemorative plaque.

THE CANADIAN WELSH RULES APPLY FOR THESE CHAMPIONSHIPS.

All Ponies and Cobs must be registered. The Owners or Lessees of the said animals must be a current member in good standing of The Welsh Pony and Cob Association of Ontario if they wish to compete in the qualifier or go on to THE WELSH CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS. Foals of the current year must be eligible for registration.

Qualifying Welsh Ponies and Cobs may be drug tested at the discretion of the Shows. Handlers in all qualifier classes must be appropriately dressed. Handlers wearing jeans, shorts, halter tops, or t-shirts will not be eligible to handle ponies. For final judging, semi formal attire is appropriate.

Should one of the Finalists be unable to appear in THE WELSH CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS at the Royal Agricultural Winter Fair, then the Chairperson of these Championships MUST BE NOTIFIED at least one month before the final judging is to take place. The Chairperson then has the right to advance the Reserve of the Qualifier. The Reserve of the Qualifier would then be eligible to receive any rewards being presented to the Finalists at the CHAMPIONSHIPS.

This event will be judged immediately after the Welsh classes in The Exercise Ring in the Horse Palace. The presentation of the winner will be made at the Evening Performance in the Main Coliseum.
